



The Foundation aims at facilitating the following services and programs:

- Social security services through implementing specific educational and recreational programs for handicapped persons.
- Help families to detect early disabilities in their children.
- Spreading fliers holding, symposia and using all media sources to raise community awareness of handicapped needs.
- Community based rehabilitation and family counseling programs.
- Offering services for professional rehabilitation of handicapped persons to help them find better life.
- Preparing programs for learning disabilities and slow learners.
- Chances for labor and to participate in community work activity.
- Offering different sport activities to help participate in Olympic sport activities specific for handicapped Athletes.
- Housing handicapped from early childhood to let holistic care and rehabilitation readily and closely available.
- Holding and actively participating in scientific conferences and workshops.
- Providing programs to learning computer scales.

The currently available services are:

- Psychometric and I.Q tests.
- Speech therapy.
- Psycho therapy and behavioral adjustments programs.
- Educational interventional programs, in addition to items nos.2 and 3, for dealing with autism.
- Specific educational programs individually tailored to each child according to his abilities.
- Physiotherapy.
- Occupational therapy.
- Rehabilitation therapy programs for cerebral palsy.
- Sensory-motor interventional therapy.
- Music and play therapy.
- Specialized sport programs.
- Scouting.
- Karate training.
